<p><u>Kintamani Volcano – Penglipuran Village – Kehen Temple – Monkey Forest – Tanah Lot</u></p> <p>Visit Rice Terrace Field, one of the more popular rice terraces to visit. You will be able to see the beautifully designed rice field and also a Monarchy Temple, which is precisely located in the foothills. Then, experience the unique characteristics, culture and the natural environment of Penglipuran Village, a traditional village in the country side. Immerse yourself in a calm, quiet and holy atmosphere in the Monkey Forest, where the monkeys in Alas Kedaton are very tame and free. Finally, visit the Tanah Lot Temple – a famous tourist destination in Bali with a spectacular view of sunset. You may even spot nooks of coral reefs around the temple.</p>	Lunch	2	80
<p><u>Glass Bottom + Turtle Island – Home Made Coffee Factory – Monkey Forest – Tanah Lot</u></p> <p>Board a boat where its bottom is made of glass, allowing you to see the underwater creatures while sailing to Turtle Island. Half way through to Turtle Island, you will also get to visit Home Made Coffee Factory where its coffee goes through many processes to produce various tastes and types. Immerse yourself in a calm, quiet and holy atmosphere in the Monkey Forest, where the monkeys in Alas Kedaton are very tame and free. Finally, visit the Tanah Lot Temple – a famous tourist destination in Bali with a spectacular view of sunset. You may even spot nooks of coral reefs around the temple.</p>	Lunch	2	90
<p><u>Bedugul – Tanah Lot – Kuta / Legian Shopping Tour</u></p> <p>Begin the tour with a visit to the Mengwi Royal Temple of Taman Ayun, then to the fruit market, followed by the Ulun Danu temple in the middle of Lake Bratan. After that, you will visit the Botanical Gardens which has more than 2000 of plants and beautiful scenery. Tour will then continue to Alas Kedaton, a sacred Holy Monkey forest, and finally to Tanah Lot temple which is perched on a rocky outcrop in the sea situated at southwest part of Bali until time for sunset.</p>	Lunch	2	80
<p><u>Tanjung Benoa Beach – Nusa Dua – Uluwatu Temple – Jimbaran</u></p> <p>Start the tour by visiting Tanjung Benoa Beach & Nusa Dua Beach which used to be a Fishing Village and an Old Dock respectively. You may enjoy your morning walk on the beaches or if adventurous enough, go for fabulous water sport activities such as Banana Boat, Jet Ski, Fly Fish, Parasailing, etc. at your own expense. After that, lunch will be at a local restaurant. You will then continue to the Ancient Pura Uluwatu Temple, which was built in the 11th century and is one of the oldest and most important temple in Bali. <i>(Note: Do not bring along any food as the monkeys in the area may steal them away from you)</i> Finally, you will proceed to Jimbaran Beach for a seafood dinner. Jimbaran Beach is an extremely tranquil beach and its sand is perfectly white. Walking or just sitting and waiting for the sunset are two of the most popular activities to do on this beach. After the romantic seafood BBQ dinner, you will be transferred back to hotel.</p>	Lunch, Dinner	2	90
