In the afternoon, continue the tour to visit **Neak Pean**, a fountain built in the middle of a pool and representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain– lake. Continue to visit **Preah Khan**, also built by King Jayavarman VII. And also visit **Ta Som** is a small Buddhist temple dedicated to the father of King Jayavarman VII and **East Mebon** which is a 10th Century temple Built during the reign of King Rajendravarmān, stands on what was an artificial island at the center of the now dry East Baray reservoir.

Itinerary: In the morning start to visit the **Roluos group** of temples. These 3 monuments, which served as the capital during the reign of King Indravaraman I (877-89), are among the earliest large, permanent temples of the Khmer classical art period. **Preah Ko**, erected by Indavaraman I in the late 9th century was dedicated by the King to his ancestors.

Bakhong is the largest and the most interesting of the Roluos group temples with its active Buddhist monastery. Lastly **Lolei**, who's four brick towers are replicas of the ones at Preah Ko, was built on an islet in the center of large reservoir by Yasovarman I; the founder of the first city of Angkor. Then move to visiting **Prolung Khmer**, a Non-Government Organization that aims to revive the ancient Khmer crafts of cotton weaving and pottery making. We proceed onto the Artisan D' Angkor where you may observe highly skilled Khmer people in the art of carving wood and stone; this well established organization ensures the survival of cultural savoir-faire and helps to promote Khmer cultural identity. These places are the perfect opportunity to pick up an authentic Cambodian souvenir and support these commendable organizations. We will then transfer back to the hotel; which conclude our tour.

Itinerary: Start tour to Tonlesap Lake. Arrive at the port and take a boat to discover way of living of people at the floating village. Besides, you can make a stopover at the 1946 built pagoda on 2700 square m² island for photo shooting. By traveling further, you will go through an impressive flooded forests stretching over 24 km², a habitat for hundreds of species. The area is just only 6 km from Conservation of Prek Toal Bird Sanctuary where thousands of water birds of live and breed. Continue to **Prek Toal**. The journey begins on a wooden boat, gliding through floating villages and a flooded forest. Arrive at the Prek Toal bird sanctuary to view both indigenous and migrating birds. We have the chance to observe birds on the brink of extinction, such as local marabous, ibis, storks, and pelicans. A conservation project is underway, and observation posts are being established for bird watchers. Picnic lunch box. Return back visit National **Silk farm**. The silk farm is a fascinating farm/workshop where you can see the entire silk creation process including growing the food for the silk worms (mulberry bushes), breeding, traditional ikat dying, pattern creation, and looming. It's a very interesting and educational tour well worth the time to drive out to the silk farm. End tour

Itinerary: Kampong Phluk is a cluster of three villages of stilted houses built within the floodplain of the Tonle Sap about 16 km southeast of Siem Reap. The villages are primarily Khmer and have about 3000 inhabitants between them. Flooded mangrove forest surrounds the area and is home to a variety of wildlife including crab-eating macaques. During the dry season when the lake is low, the buildings in the villages seem to soar atop their 6-meter stilts exposed by the lack of water. At this time of year many of the villagers move out onto the lake and build temporary stilted houses. In the wet season when water level rises again, the villagers move back to their permanent houses on the floodplain, the stilts now hidden under the water. Kampong Phluk's economy is, as one might expect, based in fishing, primary in shrimp harvesting.

Kampong Phluk sees comparatively few foreign visitors and offers a close look at the submerged forest and lakeside village life as yet unperturbed by tourism. The area can be reached by boat from the Chong Khneas or by a combination of road and boat. Make arrangements through your guesthouse or tour operator, or charter a boat at the Chong Khneas docks. By road/boat, take a car or moto to Roluos village just off Route #6 east of Siem Reap and then take a boat through the flooded forest the rest of the way to the village. During the dry season the road is clear and you can drive all of the way to the village.

Back to town, we proceed onto the Artisan D' Angkor where you may observe highly skilled Khmer people in the art of carving wood and stone; this well established organization ensures the survival of cultural savoir-faire and helps to promote Khmer cultural identity. These places are the perfect opportunity to pick up an authentic Cambodian souvenir and support these commendable organizations.
