Sight Seeing Join Tour in Siem Reap

1. ANGK – SIC 01: Half Day Floating Village – Kampong Phluk (08:30-14:00PM // 14:00-18:30PM)

Itinerary:

Kampong Phluk is a cluster of three villages of stilted houses built within the floodplain of the Tonle Sap about 16 km South-East of Siem Reap. The villages are primarily Khmer and have about 3000 inhabitants between them. Flooded mangrove forest surrounds the area and is home to a variety of wildlife including crab-eating macaques. During the dry season when the lake is low, the buildings in the villages seem to soar atop their 6-metre stilts exposed by the lack of water. At this time of the year, many of the villagers move out onto the lake and build temporary stilted houses. In the wet season when water level rises again, the villagers move back to their permanent houses on the floodplain, the stilts now hidden under the water. Kampong Phluk's economy is, as one might expect, based in fishing, primary in shrimp harvesting.

2. ANGK – SIC 02: Full Day Angkor Wat Tours

Itinerary:

Visit the **South Gate** (with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk) the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** (12th century) and visit **Bayon Temple** (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara), the **Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephants Terrace** and the **Terrace of the Leper King** and drive to a local restaurant for lunch. In the afternoon, Visit the **Ta Prohm Temple**, embraced by the roots of enormous fig trees. And visit the 7th world heritage, **Angkor Wat** a unique and stunning blend of spirituality and symmetry, an enduring example of man's devotion to his Gods. It is the largest and undoubtedly the most breath taking of the monuments of Angkor and it is widely believed that it is the largest religious structure in the world.

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3. ANGK – SIC 03: Full Day Tour Banteay Srei & The Grand Circuit

Itinerary:

In the morning, start the tour to visit **Banteay Srei**, the exquisite ‘Women’s Citadel’. Located 32 km from Siem Reap town, this was Cambodia’s last major Khmer temple to be re-discovered. The major **Pre Rup temple**, built by Rajendravarman II in late 10th century. Architecturally and artistically superior temple-mountain. Beautiful carved false door on upper level, as well as an excellent view of the surrounding countryside. And also visit **Ta Som** is a small Buddhist temple dedicated to the father of King Jayavarman VII and **East Mebon** which is a 10th Century temple Built during the reign of King Rajendravarman, stands on what was an artificial island at the center of the now dry East Baray reservoir. Continue to visit **Preah Khan**, also built by King Jayavarman VII.

4. ANGK – SIC 04: Full Day Tour Phnom Kulen Water Fall

Itinerary:

A morning trip to **Phnom Kulen** where the river of 1000 lingas features thousands of carvings engraved into the sandstone rocks under the water. We also visit **the Rock temple** which has a large reclining Buddha. There are two main **waterfalls in Phnom Kulen**: First waterfall: 4-5 meter tall and 20-25 meter wide during the dry and rainy seasons respectively. And second waterfall: 15-20 meter tall and 10-15 meter wide during the dry and rainy seasons respectively. And we also visit **Preah Ang Thom** is an 8 meter tall statue of the reclining Buddha reaching nirvana. The statue is carved into a huge sandstone boulder. Preah Ang Thom is the sacred and worshipping god for Phnom Kulen. There are also two big trees of Cham Pa at nearby. Besides Preah Ang Thom, there are Chhok Ruot, footprint of Preah Bat Choan Tuk, Peung Chhok, Peung Ey So and Peung Ey Sey. Take a picnic lunch by the waterfall.

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5. ANGK – SIC 05: Full Day Koh Ker Temple – Beng Mealea Temple

Itinerary:

Full day tour to visit **Koh Ker** is 100 kilometers away from Siem Reap. It was the capital of Khmer Empire, and very unique period in the Age of Angkor. From the time, Khmer capital was first moved to the Angkor area in the late 9th century, it would remain there for almost 500 years. On the way back, en route and discover **Beng Melea temple**. The sprawling jungle temple covering over one square kilometer is largely overrun vegetation. Constructed in a distinctly Angkor Wat style, it preceded and may have served as a prototype for Angkor Wat.
