

Brief Itinerary:

- Day 1 – Arrive in Ho Chi Minh
- Day 2 – Cu Chi Tunnels – Ho Chi Minh City
- Day 3 – Ho Chi Minh – Mekong Delta
- Day 4 – Ho Chi Minh
- Day 5 – Ha Noi
- Day 6 – Ha Long Bay Day Tour
- Day 7 – Depart Ha Noi

Day 1: Singapore → Ho Chi Minh (-/-/D)

- Xin Chao! Welcome to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam! You are welcome at airport with warmest atmosphere. Transfer to hotel for check in.
- **Dinner on cruise on Saigon river**
- Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 2: Cu Chi Tunnels – Ho Chi Minh City Tour (B/L/D)

- After breakfast at hotel, drive 70kms from Ho Chi Minh City, stopping en route to visit a rice paper making village, and you will reach **Cu Chi Tunnels**.
- After an introductory video, viewing various mantraps, the remains of an American tank and numerous bomb craters, you will spend the next hour exploring the maze of tunnels to see how the Viet Cong survived in this underground network.
- Lunch at local restaurant before transfer back to Ho Chi Minh
- In the afternoon, visit **Reunification Palace**, the home and workplace of the President of South Vietnam during the Vietnam War. It witnessed the end of the Vietnam War during the Fall of Saigon on April 30, 1975, when a North Vietnamese Army tank crashed through its gates. Today this building is a museum and sometimes a venue for official receptions. You can visit the “War Room” from where the South Vietnamese forces were controlled, and most poignantly, the room where the North Vietnamese army took official control in 1975.
- Then visit the **Notre Dame Cathedral**, built between 1877 and 1883, most materials for Saigon's Notre Dame Cathedral were imported from France. Neo-Romanesque in form, it is a major centre of Catholicism in modern Vietnam, and one of the city's major landmarks. **It was closed until Dec 2019 so you will visit outside only.**
- Next to the cathedral stands the **Saigon Post Office**, a classic French colonial structure, is still a functioning post office today and features huge ceilings, a giant portrait of Uncle Ho, and many beautiful details.
- Final visit of the day is to **Ben Thanh Market** –a symbol of the city, stands in the centre of District 1. Packed to the rafters with everything from fruits, nuts, tourist kitsch to true bargains, it is a definite must-see.
- Other shopping centre if time permit.
- Dinner at local restaurant.
- Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

Day 3: Ho Chi Minh – Mekong Delta in My Tho – Ho Chi Minh (B/L/D)

- Today, you will drive to Mekong Delta area to enjoy one day **Mekong Delta Tour (My Tho)** with visits to villages and markets.
- After breakfast at hotel, you will depart from hotel at 0830am. Our guide will meet you at the hotel and you will leave the hustle and bustle of Saigon and head to My Tho, the closet delta town to HCMC.
- After the 90 – minutes drive, you will arrive in My Tho. Starting our delta trip with a visit to **Vinh Trang Pagoda**, the most beautiful and ancient pagoda in Mekong Delta.
- After that, we continue to the boat quay, enjoying a scenic cruise, crossing Tien River to **Thoi Son 5 Island**. Here, you will visit fruit orchards, listen to the traditional music performance, “cai luong” by local people & and enjoy fruits.

- Get in horse cart on nice road the next **Thao Nguyen Orchid Flower Gardens** and have a great chance to while tasting tea – honey bees.
- Leaving Thoi Son, we continue our **boat trip to fishing villages** around the Phoenix Island. You can visit houseboats and learn how the locals feed Red Tilapias fish.
- Continue to boating to **Ankhanh Canal & Mrs. Ut Phím's house** in Ben Tre is our next destination where you can communicate with the locals – taste the coconut candy- special products of Ben Tre province. After a walk on a village path, we take a wooden rowing boat along narrow channels under the shadow of water coconut trees for deep look into the Mekong river life.
- **Have lunch** in southern style at Mien Tay riverside restaurant (or Vuondau- depend for time) that is famous for **Elephant Fish** as well as other delicious local specialties.
- Back to land where our waiting vehicle will transfer you back to Ho Chi Minh
- Upon arrival in hotel. Free at leisure by your own
- Dinner at local restaurant
- Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

Day 4: Ho Chi Minh – Flight to Ha Noi (B/L/D)

- After breakfast at hotel, free at leisure by your own until transfer back to the airport for flight to Ha Noi.
- Upon arrival in Ha Noi. You are welcomed at airport with warmest atmosphere by our guide and driver.
- Lunch at local restaurant before transfer to hotel.
- Check in hotel (following to check in time) for short rest and relax.
- Gather at lobby of hotel to proceed for the Hanoi City Tour by 'cyclo trishaw' bustling of 36 streets (partial street only) for about an hour. From this **cyclo tour**, you will get to see some of local trades.
- Dinner at local restaurant
- Overnight on in Ha Noi

Day 5: Ho Noi Highlights – Land transfer to Ha Long City (B/L/D)

- In the morning, your waiting guide and driver will welcome you at your hotel and drive you to **Ho Chi Minh Complex**. This complex features the mausoleum of the founder of modern Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh. If it is open, you can walk through **the mausoleum** to view his body. You can also see the **Presidential Palace** and **Uncle Ho's house on stilts** in the park-like complex.
- The **One Pillar Pagoda** is the next visit, which is actually a group of structures that collectively make up a pagoda built over the water in the middle of a square lake.
- Following is a visit to **Temple of Literature** – a peaceful complex dedicated to Confucius. Built in the 11th century, it was the first university in Vietnam and, still today, students come here to burn incense before important exams. You will find it great for photography, the solemn atmosphere tinged with incense smoke and the sunken lotus ponds populated by fish and turtles.
- Drive to Hanoi Center, pay a visit to **Sword Lake & Ngoc Son Temple**.
- Have lunch at local restaurant before transfer to Halong city. Enjoy the journey through the rich farmlands of the Red River Delta and the scenery of rice fields.
- Upon arrival on Halong city. Free at leisure by your own for relaxing.
- Have dinner at local restaurant.
- Overnight in Halong.

Notes:

- - Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is closed on Mondays, Fridays, all afternoons
- - Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is also closed on Oct – Nov every year for renovation activities
- If your travel date falls on any of these days, we will switch it to the next day or find alternative options for you

Day 6: Ha Long Bay Day Cruise – Land transfer back to Ha Noi (B/L/D)

- After breakfast at your hotel, cruise on the local junk for about 4 hours within the bay dotted with the more than three thousands small islets of different shapes.
- During these 4 hours' cruising, you will visit to **Thien Cung Cave (Heavenly Palace Cave)** which is one of Vietnam's most famous cave, stored hundreds of his surprise weapons, sharpened stakes, prior to a battle with the invading Mongol ships.
- A delicious seafood lunch will be served on board before transfer back to the dock.
- Return to Hanoi city in the afternoon. On the way, visit the hand – made pottery villages for shopping of souvenirs.
- Upon arrival at Hanoi, check in hotel for a short rest and quick wash – up if time permits.
- Have dinner at local restaurant.
- Free at leisure by your own.
- Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 7: Ha Noi – Departure (B)

- Morning free at leisure in Ha Noi and do some last minute shopping before taking your flight
- End of service.
